Admission Requirements:

1. The student must have a Bachelor’s degree or is expected to complete a Bachelor’s degree by the completion of certificate requirements.
2. The student maintains a 2.75 to complete the certificate.
3. No grade less than a “C” is earned in the major specific courses.
4. Residency Requirement: The student must complete 18 hours or half of the total hours at Oklahoma State University in order to receive a certificate from OSU.
